TECHNICAL DATA

FOREMOST 537-ES DRESS UP

DESCRIPTION: Foremost 537-ES Dress Up gives dull-looking tires new life. It leaves an incredible, wet-looking shine that lasts through multiple washes. Keeps new tires looking their best and rejuvenates older tires to a like-new, deep luster. So easy to apply, just spray on and walk away – no buffing required. Can sprays from any angle – even upside down! FM 537-ES Dress Up keep tires looking blacker longer while preventing cracking, browning, and premature aging. Provides a deep gloss that lasts for weeks!

APPLICATION: For use on automobiles, motorcycles, recreational vehicles, airplanes, etc. Also great for trim, mud flaps, and other rubber surfaces. Areas of use include automobile dealers, detail shops, car washes, fleet maintenance, airports, repair shops, and RV dealers.

DIRECTIONS: **READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USING. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.**

IMPORTANT: FM 537-ES DRESS UP IS SLIPPERY AND SHOULD NOT BE USED ON OR NEAR: GAS, BRAKE, OR CLUTCH PEDALS; STEERING WHEELS; SEATS OF MOTORCYCLES OR BICYCLES; OR OTHER SURFACES THAT MAY BE ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY A SLIPPERY COATING. Store can at 50°F to 80°F. Cold temperatures will lower propellant pressure, resulting in poor spray performance.

Hold can 8 to 10 inches from tires or surface to be sprayed. Direct spray head away from face. Using a steady hand motion, apply a uniform coating to clean tires for best results. If desired, FM 537-ES Dress Up may be sprayed on a rag and wiped on tires. Although FM 537-ES Dress Up will not harm or discolor most materials, always test first on a small, out-of-sight area before using on rubber surfaces.

PRECAUTIONS: **DANGER:** Extremely flammable. Contains acetone and petroleum distillates. Do not use around ignition sources such as heat, sparks, open flame, hot metal, static electricity, electric motors and compressors, etc. Do not smoke while using. Do not inhale mist or vapors. Use with adequate ventilation. Do not swallow. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not allow eye contact. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. Store in a cool (under 120°F) dry location away from heat, sparks, open flame, and direct sunlight. Do not deliberately concentrate and inhale vapors. Replace cap when not in use. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Direct spray away from face.

FIRST AID: **If in EYES:** Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, lifting eyelids to insure complete removal. Get immediate medical attention. **If on SKIN:** Wash thoroughly with soap and water while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. Launder contaminated clothing before reuse. **If INGESTED:** Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician or poison control center immediately. **If INHALED:** Get to fresh air. If breathing has stopped, qualified personnel should administer artificial respiration.
