## FOREMOST FM 889-ES DEBRIS BLOCK

**DESCRIPTION:** A proprietary blend containing an all natural active agent designed to provide a clear film barrier against debris reformation for an extended period of time.

**APPLICATION:** Suitable for use on painted and unpainted metal, concrete and wood.

**DIRECTIONS:**

1. Manually clear area of debris.
2. Ready to use formula - easy to apply
3. Adjust sprayer nozzle to a fine mist and spray evenly on the cleaned surface.
4. Reapply: Indoors - 1 to 2 times a year. Outdoors - 3 to 4 times a year
